


Weekly Wrap-Up Newsletter

Footpath for Sinasu school at Ambu village of Auki is progressing well. Currently workers are assembling the form work ahead of concrete slabing. At present 40 percent of the job is done. Over the coming days workers will continue connecting the footpath to the primary division of the school.

News/ Announcements.

1. Despite Slow Start Vaccination Rollout Program Continues. "It is our hope that COVID-19 vaccination will start rolling out in Western Province as early as next Monday, 12th April 2021 to be followed closely by the roll out in Choiseul province and then Malaita outer Islands", Prime Minister Manasseh Sogavare says in his most recent statement on Tuesday 6th April.

- There is an increased number of influenza-like illnesses in Sikaiana. Prime Minister Manasseh Sogavare reported this in his weekly address. Sogavare says that the government has received reports of influenza like illness and increased cases of diarrhoea at Sikaiana. Sikaiana, an atoll in the Malaita Outer Islands (MOI) continues to experience food shortages as the impact of saltwater intrusion and storm surges continue to affect their garden patches.
- 3. Government Approves New Tax Measures to Boost Revenue. The government also agreed to review the current tax regime on mineral exports in 2021 with the intention to impose export duty on the exports of mineral products.
- 4. The UN Development Programme in Solomon Islands, in cooperation with the Government of Solomon Islands and the International Labor Organization (ILO), is delivering a one-month training leadership in peacebuilding programme for youths in the Weather Coast of South Guadalcanal.

Work has also started for the construction of the third market stall in Munda. Team are working hard to complete the stall over the coming weeks. So far Munda residents are happy to see new market stalls are built which will boost vendors to proactively engage in supplying local food for Munda residents.
