Mata Valley footbridge in Progress



Mata Valley footbridge in the lower Kola ridge of Central Honiara is progressing well. This week there was concrete pouring on the basement. Next week the workers will work on aligning the beam on to the basement.

Barana public space improvement



Work on the Barana public space improvement on their water catchment is progressing well. This week workers put up the structure for the shed.

Significant story - Janet Hilson



Janet is a 34-year-old mother of 4 children who lives in Fasitoro community, Auki, Malaita Province. She attended ISDT under Batch 7 in 2019 and in 2020 was in engaged in short term work that built the footpath at the Town End school, Auki. Before ISDT, Janet and her husband were both unemployed and their only source of income was from selling of buns and life was very tough economically.

She was desperate for an opportunity to help ease the hardship of trying to survive in an urban setting without a job. In January 2021, Janet saw an advertisement for cleaners for the Auki Town Council, Malaita Province and with the help of the Auki team in job coaching, she placed an application and was shortlisted for an interview. Janet said the mock interview session done in the 'Seeking Employment' session of the ISDT and interview coaching received had greatly helped her to confidently answer the questions asked during the interview. Janet got the job she applied for and she is very thankful to the CAUSE Project.

Agape road



Work on the concrete road at Agape of West Honiara has started. A visit to the site this afternoon witnessed workers working on the already slab section. By next week they will move further down and hopefully by the end of the month it should be in the completion stage.
