1. One of our Honiara PMU staff Eddie Meke lost his father this week. On behalf of the Project Manager, staff and all our volunteers we sent our deepest condolences to his family during this difficult time.
2. A Malaysian national has tested positive for COVID-19. The infected person is a crew member of a logging carrier vessel that is currently anchored outside of Gizo town in the Western Province.
3. Staff at the Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock (MAL) have joined citizens both in Honiara and across the country in the fight against COVID-19 by taking their Covid-19 vaccination.
4. The seven people feared dead after their boat failed to reach their destination were found safe and well. Police in Buala, Isabel Province, confirmed that the seven missing people managed to paddle back to safety after their fuel ran out.
