## Noro fish Completed



The Noro fish market improvement has been completed. There are minor jobs and cleaning up for next week then waiting for the handing over ceremony. So far Noro residents cant wait to use the completed facility. They describe it as clean and properly designed for vendors comfortability.

## Gizo Corner Shop footpath



A new footpath at Gizo height has started last week. The footpath runs from Corner shop down to TC area. There are twenty labourers engaged for this projects. The 120 meters plus footpath is expected to complete within 52 days.

## **Gizo ISDT Training**



A total of 32 people of Gizo selected communities had been successfully completed their ISDT training last Friday. The graduates will now be engage in the construction of the third new jetty at the Gizo market and rubbish collection in Gizo town .

### Honiara -Jericho Jacob's ladder



A new 270 meters long Jacob's ladder (concrete stairway) is currently being constructed at Jericho community of Central Honiara. It starts from the main road at the top and stretches right down to the community along the valley. The project commenced construction in August and expected to be completed by the end of this month. The construction is being undertaken by members of the Jericho community who trained under CAUSE Project's 7-day Life-Skills Training. Of the 22 workers, 12 are female members while 10 are male.

Footpath around Munda market is progressing well at the moment. The footpath will connect the three market buildings and the ablution block. Already market vendors are excited and looking forward for the completion.

#### Mbokona clinic



Work on the footpath at Mbokona clinic of Central Honiara is going well. Currently the workers are filling up and compacting the area with sand ahead of slabbing next week. It is expected the project will be complete by end of this month.

## Auki - Kunu footpath



A new footpath at Kunu of Auki is shaping up well. The footpath will make life easy for people who usually collect water in the nearby water source. The water source will be improved as well.
