Work has commenced on the cleaning up and improvement of the Point Cruz under pass. The under pass has been closed for some years now and it is an eye sore for the public who walked past the area every day. Currently the workers are setting up temporary barricade in that area and in the coming weeks work will kick off properly.

Mataniko Pikinini Clinic Improvement



Mataniko pikinini clinic at China town is currently under improvement as of yesterday. The improvement will consist of big open waiting area and footpath around the clinic. The clinic is temporarily suspended until the first phase of the project is completed.

Climate resilience road at Mbokonavera 5



The climate resilience road improvement at Mbokonavera 5 in Central Honiara is progressing well ahead of time. This week the workers completed the first lane. Next week they will work on the second lane.

Auki –Kunu footpath



Kunu footpath in Auki now reach 100 meters. In the coming weeks workers will work on the remaining sections. So far people living in and around Kunu area were very pleased with this latest development as it helps them so much especially during raining season when the road is muddy.

Auki Primary school drainage improvement



Work is currently underway in Auki for the improvement of the Auki Primary school. This week the workers are pulling and aligning the culvert to ensure water flow correctly into it. Work is still ongoing and expected to complete at the end of the month.

UNWomen/ CAUSE Munda Market



The UN Women and CAUSE co-funded Munda market has finally completed. Currently workers are just doing cleaning up. The market is planned to be handed over to the Western provincial government in the first week of December.

CAUSE Gizo new office space



Renovation is currently underway in Gizo for the project new office space. The current office space is small and cannot accommodate all the staff. The project acknowledge and thank the province for the continuous support.

Announcements

1. The Project Seventh Implementation Support Mission will commence on November 22-29, 2021.
2. 239,438 doses of COVID-19 vaccines, which includes both the AstraZeneca and Sinopharm Vaccines 1st and 2nd doses, have been administered as of Friday last week 5th of November.
3. Amid Solomon Islands' continuous efforts to increase COVID-19 vaccination rates, the private sector aligns with the Government through the Ministry of Health and Medical Services (MHMS). A three-day awareness program was held to disseminate information to help communities in and around Honiara gain better understanding and make informed decision about COVID-19 vaccines.
4. The Pacific Climate Change Centre (PCCC) showcased the outstanding outcomes of its training programmes of adaptation, mitigation, and access to climate finance to increase climate investment in the Pacific during a COP26 side event "Strengthened Resilience to Climate Change in the Pacific: from Capacity Building to Climate Investment"
