Cleaning up is currently underway at Noro market ahead of the official handing over of the market to the province next week. The handing over will be grace by the Honiara City Clerk, PS Ministry of Infrastructure Development and officials from UN Women, World Bank and the project.

#### **Announcements**

- 1. Official handing over of Munda, Noro and Gizo market will be next week on 7th and 8th December 2021.
- 2. Damages to the building infrastructures through burning and looting occurred at China town and ranadi of Honiara are estimated to be around SBD\$306 million.
- 3. The New Zealand government has confirmed that it will be deploying dozens of Defence Force and police personnel to Honiara tomorrow to help restore peace and stability in Honiara.
- 4. Former professional player and experienced national age-group coach Batram Suri has been named as the new manager of the Solomon Islands women's national football team.
- The World Bank's Board of Executive Directors has approved US\$15 million in support for Solomon Islands' economic recovery from the pandemic, together with US\$5 million for technical assistance for Solomon Islands to improve the regulation and implementation of key laws for better transparency in the mining
