Jericho Jacob's ladder Progressing



The Jericho Jacob's ladder at West Kola ridge of Central Honiara is progressing well after sometimes break due to the COVID 19. Work is progressing and soon the ladder will be completed.

Disability Centre in Henderson to benefit from road rehabilitation



The Bethsaida disability centre of Henderson in the GP zone will benefit from a 2.56km road rehabilitation. The road rehabilitation will start from the junction at New Zealand camp right through the fighter 1 community. It is expected that more than 200 residents will be benefit from the road improvement.

Two new climate resilient spot improvement has been completed in the Mbokavera 1 and 5 of Central Honiara. Work will then resume for lane two of same improvement at Tehamurina and Boston still in Central Honiara.
