News/ Announcements.

1. The United States Agency for International Development (USAID) announced the launch of its five-year (2022-2027) Pacific Islands Strategic Framework that will guide the Agency's work in 12 Pacific Island countries. The strategy supports the U.S. government's goal to promote a free and open, connected, prosperous, resilient, and secure Indo-Pacific.
2. The Ministry of Health and Medical services says it is still in the process of releasing containers at the Solomon Ports and stocking up on medical supplies to health facilities in the country, including the National Referral Hospital (NRH).
3. Solomon Airlines has confirmed the airline has regrettably ceased all flights to Lata effective immediately due to the deteriorating condition of the runway. The airline has now suspended operations until further notice, until the runway can be repaired. Flights to Lomlom are also affected due to no fuel supply being available at Lomlom Airport.
