Last December 2021, the project handed over first Jetty to the Western Provincial Government. PS Western Province requested another two jetties to help the struggling women accessing the Gizo market. Yesterday afternoon in Gizo the project once again handed over the two new boat jetties to the province. It took four months to construct the jetties. The Western Provincial Government thanked World Bank for the funding and the national government for the continuous support.

1. Major aviation, road and bridge investments will soon commence as the Government, through its key Ministries including Ministry of Finance and Treasury, the Ministry of Communication and Aviation (MCA) and the Ministry of Infrastructure Development (MID) and the World Bank Group Team agreed on the terms and conditions of a Financing Agreement.
2. The Ministry of Health and Medical Services (MHMS) has recorded another 1,226 new COVID-19 cases over the past 72 hours, bringing total case count to 14,182.
3. Ministry of Health and Medical Services (MHMS) together with World Health Organization (WHO), Guadalcanal provincial government and communities at Avuavu, officially opened the Area Health Centre with great excitement. The Avuavu New Health Facility is an SBD\$16 million dollars' project funded by the Korean Government (KOICA) through the World Health Organization.
