- 1. The CAUSE Implementation Support Mission # 9 will be held from November 7-16, 2022
- 2. The Ministry of Environment, Climate Change, Disaster Management and Meteorology (MECDM) this week, launched its new Corporate Plan for 2022-2024.UNDP remains a long-standing partner of the MECDM for many years and within the framework of the Integrated Disaster Risk Management project, the team provides technical and capacity-building support to the Ministry on the implementation of the Corporate Plan.
- 3. The government, through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and External Trade (MFAET), remains steadfast in committing up to 5,000 workers into the Pacific Australia Labour Mobility (PALM) scheme by the end of 2022, with further opportunities from New Zealand on the horizon. The total figures for both countries now stand at 4,547 workers with Australia the most sought after with 4,135 workers, and 412 Solomon Islanders now employed in New Zealand.
