1. AUSTRALIA will provide an estimated AUD\$169-Million in Overseas Development Assistance (ODA) to Solomon Islands in 2022-23, including AUD\$103 -Million bilaterally, the Australian High Commissioner to Solomon Islands, Dr Lachlan Strahan announced, Thursday this week.
2. The country is set to have a new State-Owned Enterprise (SOE) by next year. This was announced by the Permanent Secretary of the Ministry of Communication and Aviation, Moses Virivolomo on Wednesday when speaking at the opening of the two-day Solomon Airlines 'Aviation Week Fair' to mark the national flag carrier's 60<sup>th</sup> Jubilee.
